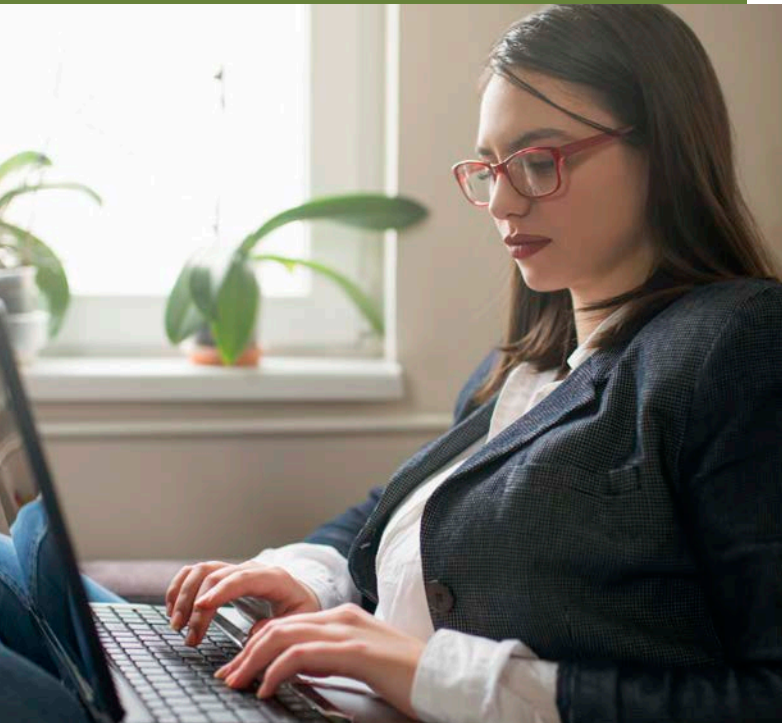

What qualification will I receive?

Diploma in Health Sciences (L5) worth 120 credits.

How long will this course take me?

One year full time or two years part time.

Will I qualify for the government fees free training initiative in 2018?

Are student loans and allowances available?

Yes, this Diploma programme is approved for loans and allowances if undertaken full time. Any further criteria are student dependent. Please give us a call and talk it through with us.

What are the entry requirements?

NCEA Level 3 with at least 14 credits in both science and technology (or equivalent) OR Certificate in Anatomy and Physiology OR New Zealand Certificate in Study and Career Preparation Level 4 with a science context OR equivalent qualification.

Do you accept international applications?

We accept New Zealand citizens, residents or permanent residents as well as residents of Australia residing in New Zealand.

Do I need to purchase any text books?

Yes. A current list is available on our [website](#).

Is my prior learning recognised?

Yes, a Recognition of Prior Learning Form (RPL) must be submitted with your enrolment form, along with supporting documentation. You can check this out on our website.

What can I do with this qualification?

Our graduates can move in to an Advanced Diploma in Health Science (L7) (Nutrition and Naturopathy) offered by the Naturopathic College. Alternatively, graduates can work for example, as Nutrition and Lifestyle Coaches or Health and Nutrition Advisors

What potential employment opportunities will I have?

Opportunities include health related businesses including (for example) supplement and food based companies, pharmacies, medical practices, midwifery practices, multi-disciplinary clinics, weight management clinics, the food service industry, community education, gymnasiums, health clubs and spas, personal training, schools, and aged care establishments.

I haven't studied for a while. Will I be able to cope?

Yes. Before starting the actual course, there is a day to look around the learning management system. Guided activities will help with this process.
